RESOLUTION

RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CANASERAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO UNDERTAKE THE ACQUISITION OF ONE 7-PASSENGER VAN AND ONE 66-PASSENGER SCHOOL BUS FOR A TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$145,000) WITH THE PURCHASE PRICE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE APPLICABLE STATE CONTRACT PRICE. PAYMENT IS TO BE MADE FROM THE CANASERAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL 2003 CAPITAL RESERVE FOR BUSES FUND BALANCE, INCLUDING INTEREST UP-TO-DATE OF WITHDRAWAL, AND REMAINDER OF PURCHASE TO BE MADE FROM THE CANASERAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL 2011 CAPITAL RESERVE FOR BUSES FUND, WITH SUCH PURCHASE TO BE PARTIALLY OFFSET BY STATE AID.
