All students must earn a minimum of 24 credits to graduate. *The passing grade for each course is* 65. In addition, all students, in accordance with Board of Education policy, must fulfill a community service graduation requirement of 20 hours of service.

# Regents Exam Requirements

All students must pass a minimum of five (5) Regents/Common Core exams (Math, Science, Global Studies, U.S. History, and English/Language Arts) in order to graduate. The passing grade for each exam is 65 for Regents credit. The Canaseraga Central School Board of Education has adopted, as policy, the 55-64 "low-pass option" for Regents exams. In these cases, identified students with disabilities may be awarded a local diploma.

Students pursuing an Advanced Regents diploma must meet all of the above requirements, plus take and pass an additional Science Regents exam, two additional Math Regents exams, and must take and pass a comprehensive exam in a Foreign Language *OR* complete a 5 unit business/career sequence.

# Special Academic Coursework

Canaseraga offers ACE courses in several subjects. These college level courses are taught at Canaseraga by our teaching staff. Students who successfully complete the ACE coursework can earn college credit through Corning Community College. Courses include Chemistry, English Composition, English Literature, Government, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Statistics, U.S. History, and World History. Many Canaseraga juniors and seniors take advantage of one- and two-year half day career and technical programs offered through the Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES center located in Hornell.

### Rank in Class

Rank in class shall be determined by using grades earned in grades 9, 10, 11 and the first three marking periods of grade 12. Course grades used to determine rank in class shall encompass all of the academic fields. All sequence course grades used to calculate yearly and cumulative averages will be unweighted with the exception of BOCES Career and Technical Education subjects.
