Canaseraga Academic & Recreation Experience

We are glad to be able to offer the Canaseraga Academic & Recreation Experience (CARE) program again during the summer of 2022. This is a four (4) week academic and recreation experience. Students completing Pre-K through 5th grade in the 2021-22 school year are invited to attend. Numerous academic and recreation staff are excited to work with your students. The program will begin on Monday, July 11 and end on Friday, August 5. This letter will give you information regarding the program. Please review this information.

Our student registration process this year will be done via a Google Form. This will place all the student information in one location. The link to the Google Form is located just below. *The registration deadline is Thursday, June 3, 2022*.

The academic / recreational program is scheduled for the days of Monday through Thursday. Our recreation staff will then be leading some outstanding trips for our "Field Trip Fridays." Some of these trips will extend beyond the typical end time of 1:00pm. The staff will be providing detailed information for each trip.

The following is the typical program schedule. There may be alterations, within the start and end times, for particular days based upon activities that are planned. Each student may eat breakfast and lunch without a cost to parents or the school district. This is offered through the federal summer feeding program.

Our program will have a school nurse in the building during program hours and accompanying the students on the field trips. The nurse will be using the medical information for your students that is currently on file with her. If you have any updated medical information, please contact the nurse to provide this information. Also, if your student normally takes particular medicines while in school (and this will continue for summer program), please be sure the nurse has a supply of the medication for use by your student.

The district will be offering bus transportation for the summer program in both the morning and afternoon for students outside the village. Students in the village will need to walk to program or be dropped-off / picked-up. If you plan to send your student on the bus, you will receive a call regarding the approximate time your student will be picked-up from and dropped-off at home. We WILL also be offering home transportation at the end of the field trips for students who normally ride the bus. Parents may also pick-up students when they return to the school building. Please be sure to indicate your transportation plans on the registration form.

If you plan to pick-up your student at the end of the program. We appreciate your diligence each day in picking-up your student at the dismissal time (1:00pm). Students will be in the foyer at the gym entrance doors. As during the school year, you will be asked to come into the building and sign-out your student. If your student is completing 5th grade, s/he may sign-out and be responsible for younger siblings (just like the process for the academic year).

We want to be clear with the expectation that students are attending the academic and recreation program portions during the week in order to be able to attend the Friday Field Trips. Students are not permitted to just opt-in to the field trips without participating in the other components of the program. We do understand students will miss periodically or for a family vacation. However, just showing up only on the field trip days will not be permitted.
