

COVID Quick Summary

The following information is meant to provide a quick summary of our COVID protocol information for 2021-22.

Main Focus

Providing in-person instruction to our students in PK-12th grade to the fullest extent possible.

Health Monitoring

It is vital for students, parents, and staff to monitor their physical well-being while paying close attention to any onset of COVID-related symptoms. Our school nurse is a great resource if you have any symptoms.

Face coverings / Masks

Face coverings / masks will be required in the school building. Based upon guidance provided by the Allegany County DOH, students will not be permitted to drop their mask if 6ft from other students in a regular classroom.

Student & Staff Screenings

Based upon current guidance, we will not be conducting screenings and/or temperature checks.

Entering the School Building

Students walking to school or being dropped off, must come through the front doors.

School Buses

Anyone riding on a school bus MUST have a face covering / mask on at all times.

Visitors to the Building

Visitors will continue to be very limited. If an in-person meeting is necessary, please make arrangements in advance with a teacher or the main office.

Dismissal for Walkers & Students Getting Picked Up

Student will be dismissed from the front and side doors again this year.

Contact Tracing

We will continue to work with the Allegany County DOH on any contact tracing that may need to be done.

Meals

Based upon guidance from CDC, we will be able to have students eat together in the cafeteria. This is much different from last year. We will be monitoring student locations during lunch time and we will be cohorting grade level as much as possible.
